

**WISCONSIN STATUTES
SUBCHAPTER IV**

Section 287.81 Littering.

Excerpts

(1) In this section:

(a) "Large item" means an appliance, an item of furniture, a tire, a vehicle, a boat, an aircraft, building materials, or demolition waste.

(2) ..., a person who does any of the following may be required to **forfeit not more than \$500**:

(a) Deposits or discharges any solid waste* on or along any highway, in any waters of the state, on the ice of any waters of the state or on any other public or private property.

(2m) ..., a person who deposits any large item on or along any highway, in any waters of the state, on the ice of any waters of the state, or on any other public or private property shall **forfeit not more than \$1,000**.

* Discarding a cigarette butt onto a highway violates this section's prohibition of discharging "any solid waste on or along any highway."
